I got a letter from T.S. last week, just two sheets the first I had rec'd since I came here. I have been at several good parties since I came here and enjoyed myself very well. Was at an excellent Dutch party last Wednesday night. My landlady and I do not get along very well for one reason. I got a flute and play dancing tunes and she kicks like thunder. I got a letter from Dr. J.E. Atwell of Jacksontown about the last I ever got. He is all right. I went with his "gall" last night from church over at Duncan's Falls. I was in Morgan county last Saturday one week ago; had a first rate time. I am thinking about going to Pike's Peak in the spring as soon as my school is out. Won't you go along.

Well I must close this time. Give my love to the family and the rest and be sure and write soon and give me all the news and a little more if you can and believe me ever your affectionate brother and devoted friend.
