

February the 24<sup>th</sup> 1823

Honored Seineon in the Gospel often informing  
you that I am in good health I wish to inform you  
that after I have enquired for Bacon and found it  
scarce the People have paid with all the Bank  
they could spare to pay their debts and there  
are yet doctor bills and hospital debts unsettled  
same by you some last year and it was said  
taken away and has spolled and they say they will  
give none others are calling but at present  
are not able. perhaps there may be some thing  
got next summer and fall but not sooner  
there are many people that have no corn and  
the hogs have died by dozens. I might say a  
many things but at a word you need not  
expect much from me soon. Yet I intend  
to try to get as much as I can.

when I look at those with other cases and  
trials my sinking flesh complains but I have found  
nothing yet that will do for an excuse in the day  
of judgement to neglect my duty pray for  
me that I may be faithful. yours &c
