July 2nd 1860

Dear Bro

I recd your letter after I wrote to you. I have been thinking some of late of coming home. If I do you will have to send me money enough to pay all my bills here as I do not want to leave in debt. If I stay till the end of the term it will cost me 15 dollars more, and I could come home and save that I want to get enough books for next year as I will study when I reach and I cannot get the books any where else likely. On the 7th day of July I will owe for Board \$12.30 then 10 dollars worth of books I have bought and not paid for and some more I want to buy 3 or 4 dollars worth likely and enough to come home on. If I had a next

write to me immediately and
let me know if you dont I will
have to stay. It will be of no
use to stay I dont believe as I could
study at home as well and could
help you also in your work

I am well tolerably so only
I dont feel as strong as a horse
Can you send me \$30. dollars
I hope this will be the last time I will

Dear Bro

I received your letter after I wrote to you. I have been thinking some of late of coming home.
