along. I am well &c.

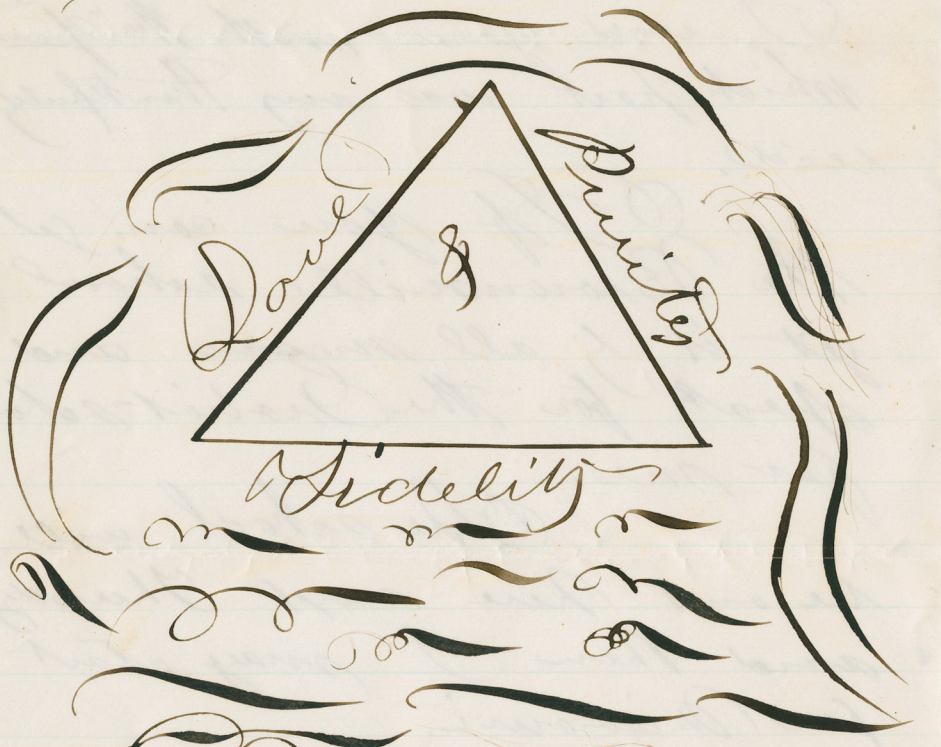
