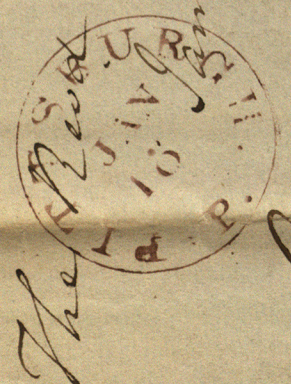

Dear Sir,

Pittsburgh, Penn^a.
Wednesday, Jan^y 12, 1825

I have the pleasure to inform you of my safe arrival in this City, this evening, in a journey of nine days from Seneca, the distance from Seneca to this place by my route 220 miles being disappointed in getting a stage in Ohio I performed the whole tour on foot. I am tired of course, but my health is better than when with you, have slept well since I left Wooster have great cause for thankfulness to God for preserving me and giving me health and strength to perform my journey thus far may his goodness and mercy accompany me

Don't neglect to have your claim allowed if possible, one half in this year 1825. and the other half in 1826 and send a paper to this effect to me under cover to Wm McLean. the Nation will be the gainer,

by allowing this claim. as if they do not. they
will loose the favour and confidence of the
War Department

I believe there is now no doubt but
that General Jackson will be our President
I hope he may do better than many of us
anticipate. we must all submit to the
voice of the Majority

I purpose going from here tomorrow or
next day, and expect to be in Philadelphia
in about 2 weeks. will write you again
My best regards to Mrs Finley and all
my friends with you including the Chiefs
with great respect y^r ob. st.
