

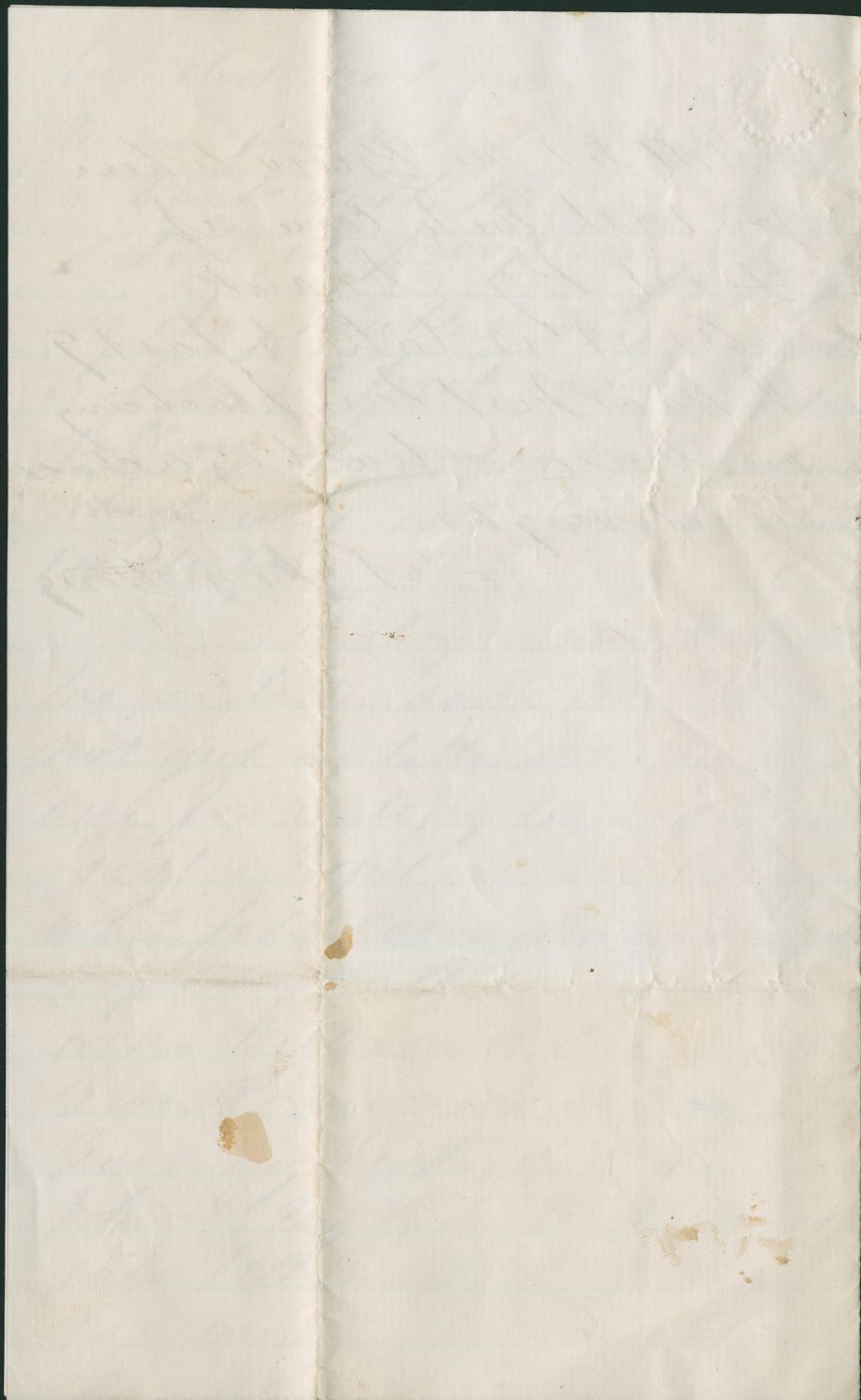

My Dear Frank

I looked all last week for a letter from George but received none. The impression I had when I left was that I was to hear from him in case that party went off. Maybe I was laboring under a false impression. Well I did not come as I supposed there would be no party. I am well and hearty. I don't know when I shall be up. I was at Camp Goddard last Sunday with some boys but did not come up to see you as I had to go back with them. My school is prospering finely. Today makes one month. I like it first rate. I am getting up a violin school which will bring me in about ten dollars.

Well you must write me a letter soon as I have not got a letter from any one for a long time. Oh, yes! I got one from Wilbur when gather came down to bring my trunk. Also I got one from poor William U Turner of Gen Rosecrans army. Give my respects to Geo & John & my love to _____ gals. Tell Geo to kiss them for me.

Well let me know when you wish me to come up. Good By Frank. As it is late 1/2 past 9. I have just been practicing on music for teaching a class.
