I wish and desire is a Good title for the Land, and if there is any claim or mortgage against the land that the may be managed in such away as to secure in me a good title, the payments I am bound to make W Spencer are as follows to wit,

In 8 weeks from the date of the contract say from 27th inst	1500
then in one year	1000
In two years	1000
In three years	1000
In four years	500
Total	\$5000

I consider it my bounden duty to give you this early information of my situation, and if there is any claim against the Land in favour of the heirs of W. Armstrong that such measures may be taken as will

secure them & me, I expect in a bout 8 days to start into Plainsville in order to try to procure the money for the first payment, It would be satisfactory to hear from you before I start
