Hillsborough Jan. 5 1826

Beloved Brother

I wrote to you a few days ago from Wilmington And informed you that I left George Sick in the neighbourhood of Washington And that I had no established place for Isaac, And I conclude that you will wish to know how we come on I will therefore trouble you with another letter — George has got well And I have taken him to Chilli Cothe. Br Wright has received him into his own family Isaac will continue here two Months and probably through the year Br Delay has written to me and informed me that he had provided ~~me~~ places for two Boys in Deer Creek Circuit Br Brandriff informs me that one or two may be sent to him at Jefferson (Pickaway) If you have any more to send you can send two to Br Brandriff (Father Nevils) and two to White Brown; <sup>Br Delay will take charge of them</sup> or if you will send them to me at any place you will mention I will receive them and distribute them. I saw Francis Asbury in Cincinnati the other day He informed me that you was going to send John Hicks to some place on Darby near Columbus I concluded that it was to Br Chenoweth as Br Donahoe had written to you I presume if it should be so that Br Donahoe will provide another place for one of them\* We have had some good Quarterly Meetings The preachers have good health and are generally in good spirits Give my respects to sister kindly Br Brooke & Family. Pray for me. May Grace Mercy and Peace attend you, Yours in Christ Jesus Rufel Bigelow—
