Urban a March 27th 1826

I rec^d. your welcome letter for
W Brooks, I will send you our hundred
Dollars (cash) and the Draft you can
send so soon as you have opportunity, it will
suit us ^{better} for you to draw quarterly than in any other
way. be good enough to draw payable to
Isaac Reynolds or order ^{at} ten days sight.

I am really sorry to hear of your
deep Afflictions. I am of Opinion, the
course which you are about to pursue
will be likely be the means of your
recovering your health in some good degree
and if I could leave home with propriety
at present, I cannot think of any business
that would be so gratifying to me as the
Journey you propose.

How much Mercy we enjoy usual health.
there has been a considerable stir among
the People here several added to the Church
many of which seem deeply interested in their
souls eternal welfare.
