Dated this 17th day of March 1862



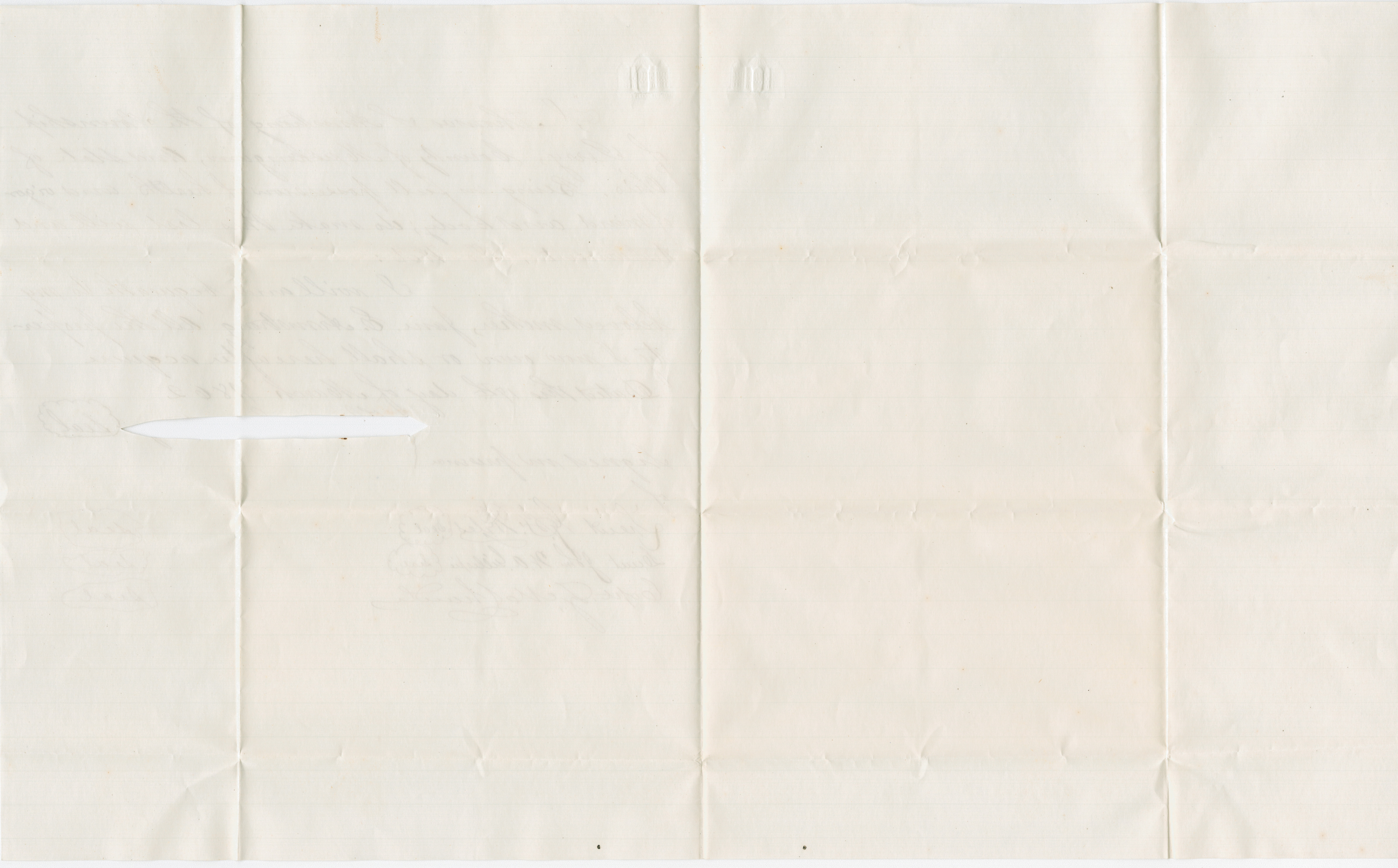
