chiefs, in case you go to the Camp-
meeting? You can go to the camp
one day and return the next,
or in case you do not go to the
camp, shall we appoint three
meetings for you?

We think it of very considerable
importance that our Brethren
with you should attend the camp
in order to produce an excitement
in the country on the subject of
refugees.

You will please to send us an
answer by return mail, for
we must make ^{our} ~~our~~ appointments
next Sabbath.
