The 27th of May 1827

My very Dear Brother at a quarter Meeting occasion here at Nuttidges meeting house I have seen and formed a very short acquaintance with a brother not long from Europe and understanding he expected to see you I have had a few moments to put you in mind of my friendship for you as the first of my Brethren that began to draw me to my present repose and how does my mind swell with thankfulness when I recollect over all the dear servants of God that has been the instruments of helping me to see the way and I hope to get along at last to join long with all the glorified company above where my Dear friend if I never see you in this world I expect to meet with you and all those who have been made beneficial to me here and spend an eternal Day where we shall see our fathers face and be forever assimilating into his likeness through the boundless ages of eternity

The learned Brother Thompson being capable to give you information of the state of the church here will supersede the necessity of my taking up time upon that subject You will be pleased to hear that my wife rather exceeds me in her attachment to the methodists four Daughters are members and I still hope the Lord will bring in and fit more in this place for his heavenly Kingdom

Dear Brother we can say no more but join in our kindest respect and Christian affection for you and family and all both white and Colored who love our Lord Jesus Christ

Brother I add no more
