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Benjamin This day
afternoon Wilber is very much
protrated he is so weak cannot
helpe him self but has care
more to day then any before
his diet wine whay a litle
cream branday lody beaf tea
he eate a pease of rosted apple
to day Mrs Smith is attending
to him most of the day time

I have slept very litle but
have stood it well cosdrong
direct your letters to forth street
hospelle he wounts Wm Armstrong
to right of you

If he don't get a back
Set he will get well

Thursday afternoon Wilber is very much prostrated. He is so weak, cannot help himself but has eaten more today than any before. His diet wine, whay, a little cream, brandy tody, beef, tea. He eats a piece of roasted apple today. Mr. Smith is attending to him most of the daytime. I have slept very little but have stood it well considering. Direct your letters to 4th Street Hospital Cincinnati. He wants you to write often.
