Nashville Dec. 10th 1829

Dear Bro.

Yesterday I received yours of the 26 of Nov^r, and wrote immediately to bro. McClain, bro. Hill will give the information requested by bro. Goddard. I rejoice to hear of the health of your family, - The comfortable state of the Church, and that things are no worse in Pittsburg. The Church is in peace in this place and prospers in some degree. Peace and prosperity attend the conference generally. Bro. Roberts did not get to the conference until the fourth day - was unwell at the close, but went on for the Mississippi conference. I intended to have gone but ~~was~~ late went from this place at the time. From Lexington I got down safe, but missed Bro. Goddard. I shall circulate in this country a little during the winter, but what course I shall take after in the spring is left to Providence. My best respects to your family, the preachers, and my particular friends in general.
