Wilmington 6th March 1830.

My Aged Friend & Brother

By the hand of
Bro. Lewis Wright of this place, I send
you these which leave me & mine in health
& peace. - I hope they may find yourself
& Sister Finley, with the inmates of your house
- hold enjoying the same blessings -
I instructed Bro. Reeves on his way to the East
to make a deposit of \$300. Mortgage, Notes &c. with
you, for Doct. Wm. W. Bunnell of Indiana - He or
his Agent will probably call on you for the same.
which you will please to hand over, if a lawful
Deed is presented for a tract of land, specified in the
Mortgage - The laws of Ind. & this State on the subject
are variant. - The Deed was written by J. M. Houston Esq.
& ascertain from Lawyer Lewis or some other legal
character, whether it is executed correctly by Bunnell -
If you receive the Deed, keep it in possession till I
see you. - I expect to be down first week in next
month. - Write to me when this comes to hand, by
mail & let me know about the business -
Also spare some room to let me know of your
welfare in the City & Station -
I am trying to do well & expect to die so. - We
have peace & some prosperity - Pray for me
till I see you - I am yours as in former times
