Wilmington 13th March 1830.

Dear Bro.

I wrote to you by Bro. Wright, which you have received by this time, & are prepared to answer by the bearer of these, Aed Bro. Coalter - how Mr. W. Bunnell or his Agent called on you for the money & papers deposited with you by Bro. Reeves? Have you recd. a lawful deed from Bunnell? if so keep it till I see you. I write to me by Bro. Coalter, as I am in a strait, & wish to know the ipse of the business - you may keep to yourself if you please, the subject upon which I write & just return to me by the bearer which I write ^{by letter} as above suggested - My dear Lord & answer - an attack of fever - But she is is ill at present. - None better I think, & as patient & pious as ever - It appears you Mr. Wesley would not blame me - It appears you are not alone with tribulation in the City yet - I mean in reference to your Mr. H. calculation - But be faithful all will turn out for the best. & penitence of our good.
