Rev & Dear Bro

Altho things are as they are at present which will be
explained at a proper time the day never was and I hope never
will be that you will not be a welcome guest under my
humble roof about a week ago my son lost religion
& has been regaining ever since & when he thought the
time of his departure my he would I want for joy
and clasp his dying hand and long to be with
the lost light of all things here below escorted us
all into the smallest child to meet him in heaven
this morning half past nine o'clock he fell asleep in
the arms of Jesus & we have no acquaintance here
but you you will do us the favour to preach
his funeral on tomorrow at 12 o'clock in my house
call us to day and see us Yours respectfully
