to you a blank Dued and a little
bond on Endre Burnett for the lot
that we design erecting our meeting
house on, with the request that you
will get the dues executed before a
Justice of the peace & the clerk certify
that he is such Justice. You
will on the Execution of the Dued
give up the bond and forward
the Dued to us by the first safe Com-
pany and I send by the bearer 75 cents
the Express of the aches and signment
and the clerk seal & certify all
Have attention to this request will
lay us under renewed obligation
to your kindness I am Dear Sir with
great Respect
