Marysville, (O.) Feb. 14, 1831.

Sir:

That earnestness in the propagation of correct principles, which your deportment has uniformly evidenced, will, it is hoped, be deemed a sufficient apology for this intrusion.

Two, or three years since they writer of this note was present at a Camp-meeting, near Davis' on the Scioto River, where a sermon was preached, by you, in opposition to the doctrine of the Arians alias New-light. The substance of that discourse is, in part, recollecte^d, but the connection is lost. Desirous of having the cogent arguments which it contained correctly embodied, I have concluded, after some hesitation, to adopt this method of making a request to that effect.

If your lecture will permit, you will conve^a a favor on myself, & many others by transmitting a connected sketch of the arguments contained in the sermon before-mentioned.
