Alma July 15 1833

Very Dear and much beloved Brother, We have just received a letter from Brother <sup>Wm</sup> H. Wapen who states that he has received letters from some of our Brethren in the Ministry proposing to remove our approaching Conference from Cincinnati to Alma or some other place from the City. As the health of the City it is believed will not justify, and the general opinion appears to be that if it not removed that the Conference will be but poorly attended. The Friends in this place are abundantly willing and fully able to support the ~~conference~~ Conference and according to the request of Brother Wapen and the solicitation of our Friends we now request you if it meets your approbation to write immediately to Bro Morris at Cincinnati and let him know your views and those of the Friends that many of the Preachers are not willing to go to the City and if it meet the approbation of the Friends in the City for Brother Morris to write us word immediately and also to forward a letter directly to the Editor of the Christian Advocate & Courant and let it immediately published that the Conference is removed to Alma and then every preacher can get the information before the time and we also will let all know we can and have all the necessary preparation made to accommodate all our Friends &c



Taking all things into consideration we are very seriously of  
the opinion that it be for the best at this time to remove it to Kenia  
We have heard some suggestions about Lebanon but think  
that you as well as ourselves know that Kenia will answer  
better Our health is tolerable, Our work encouraging  
and we are looking forward with anticipation of great  
Good. Please to write immediately to Morris upon the receipt  
of this and with this scroll receive the assurance of our contin-  
ued love and that you have a share in our poor Unworthy  
petitioning before a Throne of Grace Pray for us, and  
for the Charge under our care and for the Guidance  
of the Almighty in respect to the Conference
