 the quarterly meeting conference of the
 Randolph Cent. Mad. Dis. Erie Conference ^{would}
 be accepted in the Conn. of which you
 are a member if I should forward one
 to you on to the conference at its
 next session. Or if would be the
 better way to join the Erie Conn. &
 obtain a transfer & forward it at the
 next session of your Conn. You will
 greatly oblige a youth that is desirous of
 trying to promote the Redeemer's cause
 by giving your advice, before the sitting
 of the Erie Conn. which will commence
 its session on the 17 of August next.
