Dear Sir

Capitola July 17, 1838

(Mr. C. Smith) I wish to be informed if the
man who owns the land in sect 14 Town
14 Range 2 east, which you entered for
him about 18 months ago, wishes to sell
a part or all of it, & the price for 40
or 50 acres on the north part, & the price
for the half sect — I informed you
a few months ago that I owned land
adjoning and wish to purchase more if it
could be had at a fair price —
I have lately been offered land adjoining
~~land~~ of equal quality at 2 to 250 per acre
but I would give preference to the first
mentioned land on account of water —
I will be very much obliged if you will
write to Mr. Smith & request him to
answer the above immediately, having
an opportunity to purchase a lot adjoining
which I wish to do soon, if I do not
buy the above land of Mr. Smith.
