Pleasant Hill Sept 13th 1840

Dear Sir

I drop you this to acquaint you with some
matters & things. all well we have waded
through our harvest at last got all up
in good order are now plowing & have
hired a young married man ~~for~~ for a year
at 11 dollars per month he boarding his self
and paying \$1.50 per month for house rent.
per wood &c. all this will bring his wages
to about \$7.50 per month his name is
John V. Tracy I paid over the 100 dollars
you left to S O King adell & he have
traded adell paid 1700 dollars for King farm
King paid 500 for the 5-acre lot near
Estaire and King has your note
there is nothing new or worth saying
Mrs Hirley has her usual health and all
well as common.

We expect to see you about the 24th
