Springfield June 4, 1841

Dear Bro. Finley -

Some important matters connected with the Springfield High School. make it necessary that there should be an early meeting of the commissioners - We have appointed the 23 of this month at 9 A.M. - I hoped to have seen you at the time of your Quarterly meeting at McFarlands, but I learned from Bro Christie who was there on Saturday that you was absent by reason of affliction - Bro. Howard is here; and I have at this time written to all the other members of the board, except Bro. Walker, he is on the District, and I do not know where to address him - Perhaps you can give him word - Do not fail to be here if in your power to attend, as your presence and council will be needed, and a full meeting is desired -

We have a good revival of religion here - souls are being converted daily - Bishop Morris has just left this place for Nebraska
