Dear Bro. Finckley

Providence having removed
our D. C. Brother Hunter, by death we shall not be
represented in the Conference (Cabinets) we have sent a
petition for the next Annual Conference to be holden
in Marietta. We now have a large meeting house
and can accommodate the Conference very well
you will recollect that twenty years have past
since the Conference was holden in this place
Bro Simmons can give particulars ~~and~~
we must solicit your influence, to get the
Conference once more in Marietta. This done we
have another request. the Brethren respectfully ask
that Bro Trimble or Bro Merrick may be ap-
pointed to this charge believing that either of
them will be very suitable for the charge
we have a great variety of Items with us, and
must wake up and keep awake, to hold the
standing we have at last obtained — Bishop
Morris made us a pleasant visit while on
his way to Conference, and can properly
