 Dear Brother I have written you a long letter by Bro Arza Brown who was here on a visit and I now drop this line so that if he has forgot to hand it over to you - you can get it from him and if possible prevent Preacher Young from being Return'd to this Station the Good Lord knows we are run down low enough already and should he come another year there will be a complete Triumph of Abolitionism Now Brother in the name of the Lord God Try and send us a good sound Methodist preacher and he shall be sustain'd - we are not the only Family that are Tir'd of him far from it I do hope he may be put on a Pair of Saddle Bags and try the Circuit somewhere if he can do any good however this I send by mail so that you may get my other letter in time Indeed I wanted to go down myself but now think I shall not get away
