Dear Brother I take This Opportunity To inform you of ^{the} ~~between~~
the death of my dearly beloved Husband he died on the 21st day
of November last being Confined to his bed Only nine days
though his health had been on the decline during all the past
season he died with inflammation on the lungs though I have
one thing that consoles me that what to me is an unspeakable
Loss is to him gain he died in the full Triumph of Faith with
full assurance of a blessed immortality beyond the Grave
William Hosier left this world on the 28th of June last with
a Lathum in his Thigh supposed by some to be white swelling
Our Children is all married and gone except James & Samuel
James has had a severe spell of sickness he has been confined to his
bed the most of the time for nine or ten weeks but is recover-
ing slowly the rest of the family is well I am as you know
left in a lonely situation having no one to Advise with me
I wish you if you possibly can to come and see me as soon
as you can I want to preach the Funeral of Joseph and if ^{you} can
so do. write to me when you can be here direct your letter to
Manwaring's office Brother Samuel lives in Laporte County
La. he was here last Sunday night but has returned home
no more at present but remains your sister
