Cincinnati Ohio Aug 24 - 45

Dear Mrs Finley,  
Fearing that bro Marley has not written to you in regard to your boarding place during the sessions of Conference I concluded to address you a line informing you that your place is A. N. Riddle, Esqr on 8th bet Walnut & Vine within two squares of the Church. I learned that Judge McLain wished you to stop with him and I was not at a loss to know the reason, Mrs Riddle refuses to let you go elsewhere, your colleagues are bro Marley & Trimble and the place delightful, You must not disappoint them, We expect you on Saturday and I want you to preach for me a missionary sermon at 9th St on next Sabbath.
