

Dear father & mother

I wrote to you from here on the 13th. I am well with the exception of a slight head ache. It being now about 4 1/2 PM I should like to have you write to me. Give me the news from our family; in particular tell Mary, Fla, Jacob, & also Frank & Gus. Send along with, or enclosed, an envelope, stamp on it, & a sheet of paper. When you write, only write two pages and put that in 1 envelope so as not to give the examining officers too much trouble.

Good bye. My love to you all. Pray for me.
