Jacksontown Pickens Co. C.
April 17th 1846

Rev. Mr. Finley

Dear Sir — Yours came to hand last evening, and as Mr. Hanson expects to start for the East in a few hours, he has requested me to answer your request as follows. Take care

Take 1. OZ. of the oil of anise
1. oz. of the oil of balsam of fir
1. OZ. of the oil of Sassafras
1. OZ. of the oil of kunkum
1. pint of rum
1. pint of the tincture of bloodroot
1. pint of the tincture of lobelia
2. quarts of rain water
2. quarts of Molasses

and to each of the oils add one pint of good alcohol, mix them all together and let them stand three or four days.
