Stamantun Aug June 24 1846

Res. James B. Finley

Dear Sir Your note dated at
State Prison came duly to hand yesterday. You speak of
the Confession you have always entertained in mind and I
should have no reason to doubt now it not that you have
so often repeated this. Now my friend I have
wrote the very best I could and all I could. Got the Taxes not paid
George and I have written several letters to the Treasurer and to my
Agent. then in the summer of 1844 and paid all the back Taxes
and the Taxes for 1844. Then before the Taxes of 1845 were paid
I sold to you. and as you state in your letter I promised to pay
the Taxes for 1845 and still promise so to do if it costs me
\$500. But you must allow me to do it as I can. I
sent out in the fall for the amount of Taxes on my Land
and George, and they sent in as acknowledgment the Taxes of 1844 for
which I held receipts in full. I then sent out my receipts to
my Agent. Requesting him to present them to the Treasurer
and then send me the amount of Taxes for 1845. and have
not yet. been able to get the amount. a few days ago
I went to Cincinnati to see George to know what he
should do about it. and he agreed that as soon
as the Roads get better one of the will go out and
have all made right and the Taxes paid off. so you
need not be uneasy about it. What I have promised to do
you may depend on.
