 R. Corner N. E. 1/4 - it is impossible to find said Land unless  
 you send Mr. the range Township Sec. 27. and also the name of  
 the person to whom it was charged on the Certificate -  
 By forwarding Mr. such information, as will enable me to find  
 said Land I will make all the necessary entries and  
 attend to having your deed recorded & transferred, and  
 return it to you. I will attend to any business of the Land  
 that you will intrust to me. If it will be any accomo-  
 dation to you. -
