Dear Brother

I arrived at this place yesterday evening
for the purpose paying off the taxes
on my land and the Deed sold to
you by my Bro. W. B. Walker. Mr
Vance the receiver could not receive
the tax for 45 unless I paid the tax
for 46 also which I have done and took
the receipt for the same. The tax on the
whole of your land purchased of my Bro
is \$4.33. I write at this time and
pardon from the fact that I have just
learned that your Agent not knowing
that I was here attending to this busi-
ness has just written to you infor-
ming you of the amount of tax due
on your land including last year as
well as this. This is there for to correct
the impression that his letter con-
-tains upon you. You can pay
me the \$4.33 as soon as may suit
your convenience. My health is not
very good. I hope this may you and you
-is in good health and spirits. Pray for me

That the Lord may be with me and finally
bring me with all the faithful to inherit
Eternal life. I am as ever yours in
the best of bonds.
