Dear Brother- }

Bro Clark - our Presiding Elder -  
delivered your message - viz that the money for Esq<sup>r</sup> Parkinson  
(\$ 75.00) was ready for me to forward to him.

My engagement with him requires  
me to pay the money in the Franklin Bank Cincinnati  
and as he will require money - equal to specie - you will  
please - if possible get the amount in Notes of the State Bank  
of Ohio - payable in Cincinnati and deposit them in the  
City Bank of Columbus - Thos Moodie - Cashier - and  
get from him a "certificate of deposit" <sup>describing the funds you deposit</sup> by you - for me  
and subject to my order - and forward it to me by  
mail to this place.

Please enquire of Mr Moodie whether  
he can give me a draft on the Franklin Bank of Cincinnati  
which I should prefer - or on any good bank there. If he  
can I will remit my \$ 50.00 to the City Bank which  
with your \$ 75.00 will make the amount of my Note  
to Parkinson viz \$ 125.00.

Please let me hear from you by return  
of Mail - if possible - as I shall have some fear of the  
mis carriage of the draft -
