German town N.Y. Sept 4. 1846

Dear Bro I sit down to tell you
in Part our Grievances There are about 40 whites
& 50 Blacks Members of the M. E. C. who feel
willing to live and die on the old ship But if
the Ohio con. or the Bishop Refuse to send us
a P. & include this place in the Augusta Cir-
cuit I don't know what will be come
of us we cannot go South our old Church
is now under an injunction But thank be
as we have New Brick Church on the
way And hope to have it finished in Nov.
I want you if possible to come and help
dedicate it Bro. Marley & Dr. Lamlins
can tell you all about our situation
& wants My Dear Bro do help Bro. Mar-
ley & use all your influence with the
Bishop or the Conference to do something
for us we think we are not hard to please
But we want a P. sent us by the Author-
ity of the Bishop or the Conference & throw
us our Brethren of the South will throw
it up to us all the year that we are
Radicals or something worse If you
have time soon as you have an
interview or know what the con-
or Bishop will do Please let me hear
from you as I am waiting with much
anxiety to hear our doom
