Brother Finley

I hope you will pardon the liberty
I have taken of writing to you, our corresponding
secretary having closed his letter and not knowing
what he has written I thought it would not
be amiss to give you some information concern-
ing the progress of this Society. I think we
commenced with about two hundred subscribers
and altho many have got tired and left us
yet many more has been added at this
time I think we have upwards of three
hundred. And I thank the Lord while
they have remembered the children of the
Forest the Lord has remembered them, we have
12 little girls who are the managers and eight
out of that number have professed to know the
forgiveness mercy of the Lord and also several
of the boys. I have truly had it been spoken
that a cup of cold water shall not lose its
reward, could you see them coming up so cheer

fully to contribute their mite it would make
your heart rejoice we have been a long about
getting it off yet I hope it will be acceptable
to your mission school, receiving a letter from
brother Gilluth concerning the clothing he express-
-ed a wish that they should be plain and strong
we have tried to select such. It would be very
gratifying to the children to know whether you
have got those little boys they have named in the
school and what age and size and how they are
coming on and what progress they are making
they would try to send them books out such
as they most needed - I sincerely hope the Lord
will continue to own & bless your labours yet more
abundantly among the Wyandots.
