Rev and Dear Sir

I have been employed
as a Missionary six years by the
British Conference, and have just
now arrived from Jamaica on my
way to Halifax for the benefit of
my family's health. We shall be de-
tained here by the Quarantine Laws
for 48 hours which I very much
regret as I have learned from this
days "Advertiser" that you have a
Missionary Meeting this evening in
New York and I think nothing
would have given me greater
pleasure than to have been pre-
sent on the occasion. I am

you and that you may increase yet
more and more in the spirit of
Missionary zeal. Hope to have the
pleasure of seeing you before you
