There is nothing special new here, excepting that we all feel outraged at the course of the Legislature. Can't you pour a little common sense into them? They ought not to receive a dollar, till they organize and begin to do the public business.

We are all well. I am

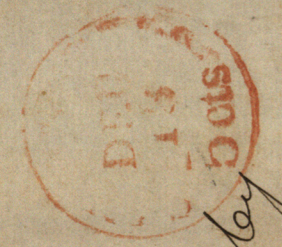
