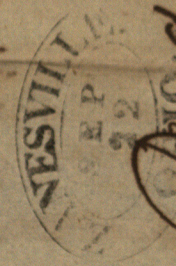

Sept 21st 1865
 I looked long for you at
 Latham's Meeting but all in vain
 then I walked away up the road till
 near meeting-time If I had suspected
 you not being there I should have
 gone to Sandusky the week before
 On my arrival at home your box (I
 sent) of Medicines were at my house
 It was there when your team got the
 salt — I have had no oppor-
 tunity of the box and
 I expect between this & conference
 to call on Caubach for that \$100
 I have no advice of Bishops & have
 no idea of who will attend our con-
 ference. I am just able to move
 about unwell for 3 weeks but not
 down

I made the old lady very glad
with the Testament on two accounts
1. An amount of the present 2. on an
-count of the source from whence
it came

My Family are pretty well
I can learn all your will at
conference if we are spared to
meet in the near time you
& your undertakings prosper
