Barnesville Sat Evening  
Nov 5<sup>th</sup> 1825

Bro

The Monday after I left  
you I set out for Wheeling on a  
week with my wife & returned this  
evening — Tomorrow I begin my  
year's work in the station

I left Barnesville yesterday morning  
Mr Davenport gave me \$18 and 14 cents  
the balance of your Missionary money  
which was in his hands it is subject to  
your order.

If you have not sent for those goods  
which were sent by Davenport to my care  
— or if you wish me to send them  
out write to me immediately — If you  
send a team or if one should be on  
the road now before I hear from you  
I will make up the rest of the load —

You see all what I mean —  
My Family are well. May you be  
successful this year — I have some ache-  
-ing of heart about my sheep —  
my trust is in God & the prayers of my  
brethren among whom I always place  
J. W. Hurley — My love to Sister  
Finley — Bro. Brooks & family — and  
all the host under your care & charge  
of your superintendency.
