Dear Sir

Feb 20. 1826

The bearer of this is Capt^l Capt^l (bro-

My object is to introduce & recommend him to
you as such. I have no personal acquaintance
with the Capt^l, but believing that he has had

-quainted with the Indian character & concerns,
his friends who are respectable presume on his
desire to be instructed by the Gov & yourself &
~~his~~ work & his work to be guided by those in-
-structions.

This will relieve you from a great burden
& the state of your health requires you to
be less responsible than you have been.
