Logan March 19<sup>th</sup> 1827

Dr Bro I acknowledge my fault in not answering yours of 23<sup>rd</sup> Jan<sup>y</sup> last — But you say if you wished to visit us when the roads become good. When you come I wish to be at home which will not be until the 3<sup>rd</sup> of April when I would be very glad to find you at my house on my arrival.

as ever I am yours

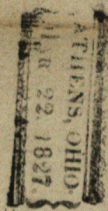
