Yours of Jan 18<sup>th</sup> (from Sandusky) was rec<sup>d</sup> in due time I was as I always am glad to hear from you. —

The materials out of which we are to make that disfranchisement report are scarce & meagre that I'm completely stup'id I expect however to see the other members of the Com. Perhaps they have more strength or ingenuity. — For it appears that unless directibility or malability, or both can be found in the little map — The Report must be both short and naïve — the religious part especially. But my only object when I sat down

Was to answer your enquiry, "When  
& how will you go to Gen. Carr"?  
The last I'll I shall attend before—  
will be Granville Cir-ill Chalfants  
Apr 19 & 20<sup>th</sup> — The next Sabbath is of  
course the 27<sup>th</sup> & 3 days is too little to  
reach Pittsburgh in — So I will  
come home 21<sup>st</sup> of April & meet  
you at my house or if you now  
meet me at Chalfants & come home  
with me.

I think to go on home back & I wish  
you to write to me that you will  
be as soon enough to go before the  
great gang, or wait in patience  
till they are gone, or take some by  
way that we may not be too much  
cramped, you see all I mean —

a week to go & come on — I am  
getting old & don't wish to hurry
