Fairville June 8<sup>th</sup> 1846

You promised in your last from Columbus that I should hear from you again shortly, but ——— Well how are you doing? your congregation I believe talk very little — And one would suppose, that music or no music, voice or no voice they would once a week if permitted strive to sing most heartily; And if you can get them into the spirit of prayer, great changes may be wrought in their hearts.

God grant that you may not labor in vain among them

I do not make more than half a hand on the Dirt it may be a blessing to the church that my reign is so short — I shall try to finish the 4<sup>th</sup> Round which begins next Saturday at Fairville hot weather oppresses me & I'm sure I could not stand the winter at all.

We have very still times in religion all over the district Town as well as country. The Southern Methodists it seems were rather puerile in their calculations, when they thought that lines & boundaries would save them from the vexed, & vexing questions of negro slavery? Vides doings of their Gen. <sup>W.C. Ad.</sup> ~~Conf.~~

My wife is still very feeble in body so that at times it is a great trial for me to leave home God bless & prosper you

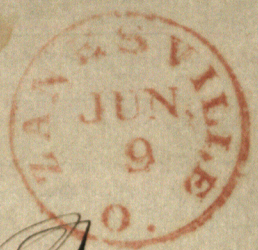
