mailed (I don't know where) "Allan O" this
morning. It is not the best kind for not
being necessary. I have not yet begun
to take the Iodine. When I get home

of which it is composed - together with the

conclusion with you. - Having ordered
my all same time since I shall not
commence taking till it arrives & then
