trouble. I was glad to hear of your own
health and the well being of your family
& the payment on your Church lot. You

We are all pretty much as when you left us —
Enclosed find a three dollar bill which will
pay the 127⁷/₁₀₀ dollars due you & the balance will
be some little mementos to please your grand-
son David —

God bless you & bring us all
to a better world, when time & old age
shall have performed their last operation
upon us —
