Eaton O. Dec 6th 1846 —

Dear Sir

I had intended to see you before you left Eaton and went up to Champaign for that purpose but you had left I wished to make some arrangements about that medicine so I will state in this communication that I have made a calculation and find it will cost twenty cents per bottle so I will inform you the arrangement I would be willing to enter into provided that gentleman in Columbus that you was speaking about wished to enter into the business of manufacturing the medicine the arrangement is this if he will will with you furnish the Capital I am willing to make the medicine for one third of the profit so you speak to him and let me know all about the matter I feel fully satisfied that we can sell a great quantity of it all over the state as you are known all over this western country and that would recommend it so that it could not help but sell and in addition to that I can get several certificates from different persons in this region please write to me on the subject —
