1847

Affectionate Grandfather

I am happy to inform you  
that I am well at present with all  
of the rest of the family except  
mother is a complaining a little  
grandmother is well and so is grandfather  
Brooke I am a going to school  
but are not learning much for I am  
neither studying geography or grammar  
and have failed my master at arithmetic  
several times, Charles is a talking of  
moving up to in dark County at  
Easter but is not a going to move  
yet not until next spring.
