Rev. Bro,

Accept this You have the Charter & Blue Books for Division of our Order at Jefferson. The Book of Constitutions is an old one & will be exchanged for a new one as soon as I can get them, I am repeating them clearly.

Enclosed, in the Package you will find Your Commission. as Deputy - Your Authority is a general One & whenever, it shall be found convenient Charters &c will be forwarded to you. Your Commission also gives You a general Supervision over any Divisions in the State that may not be in charge of other Deputies. No Deputies have as yet been appointed. As soon as they are, You will be advised through the "Organ" so that no Collision shall take place.

You will report, at Your earliest convenience whenever, You open Divisions, the names of Officers & the time of opening - Also after Inspection and Installation as well as the general Condition of the Order. - Enclosed You have the prop Word for the current Quarter, which You will give to such Divisions in the State, that You may find without it, provided they have made their Quarterly returns not otherwise.
