Datto Annonias Feb 5th 1837

Dear Grandfather

This morn^g I am in
but moderate health. The day you
passed through our town I was
taken with the most violent cold
I ever have had & suffered much
violent fever and all its attendants
consequently I to day feel some
better. The rest are in usual
health - I learned this morning
by a traveller that New Castine is
situated in Butter township Darke
county I suppose this is correct
as he said he lived within 9
miles of Castine and he would
certainly know if there should
be any mistake I suppose it
could easily be rectified
I think of moving next week
towards the lake if health
and the roads permit I shall
write to you the day before I
leave here and inform you
of particulars. I want you
to make every effort to get the
appointments for me and write
soon your success yours in
